Maths We will revisit the language of more, less and fewer as part of the vocabulary required for addition and subtraction. We will be starting with using two sets of objects to add, then move to counting on as a way of adding.

Expressive Arts and Development

We will be designing our own houses and Nursery class, getting ideas from the building project going on around us. We will also be acting out our stories and drawing pictures to represent characters and settings.

Personal, Social and Emotional

<u>Development</u> Our focus will be on thinking about ourselves positively; knowing the things we are good at and being proud of this.


<u>Communication and Language</u> We will be focusing on listening for understanding. When listening do we make relevant comments or ask questions about what we have heard?

Understanding of the World

We will be looking at the part technology plays in our lives; from computers, mobile phones, tablets as well as within the wider world; self-service checkouts and traffic lights. We will be using age appropriate software and developing our skills.

Literacy We will be starting the topic linking to the changes that are happening with the Nursery, by looking at the story of the Three Little Pigs. Our focus will be on writing sentences and increasing the number of high frequency words we are able to spell correctly and apply in our writing. We will be continuing to develop our knowledge of long vowel sounds both in our reading and in our writing.

Physical Development Our focus this half term is on being healthy. We will be looking at food, exercise, sleeping, brushing our teeth and washing as things that contribute to a healthy lifestyle. In PE we will focus on safe practises.

Glossary of key vocabulary

This is a list of some of the key vocabulary for the learning this term and ways to support your child using them at home.

High frequency words

These tend to be the tricky words that you can't use phonics to read. The first high frequency words that we learn in Reception are; \mathbf{I} , the, me, my, no, to, of.

Moving on to; said, you, your, are, be, into

Long vowel sounds

ay, ee, igh, ow, oo, oo ar, or, air, ir, ou, oy

Less and fewer In maths, less refers to one less where as fewer is any

number that is smaller; so if the number was 10, one less would be 9 and fewer could be any number from 0 to 8.

Counting on This is when you 'put the first number in your head' and add the second number (or set of objects to represent the number) to it. This is a great way of knowing if a child is really secure with the number order, rather than just knowing the numbers by rote, as a song rather than understanding what they mean.
