Agreement for School:

The Reddings Primary and Nursery School will:

- warmly welcome you to our school
- provide an exciting, safe and secure learning environment
- communicate with all children/parents/carers in a respectful manner
- empower your child to reach their full potential
- have clear and effective systems of communication
- contact you to celebrate success or discuss any concerns we may have
- keep you fully informed of your child's progress and learning outcomes
- offer a broad and balanced curriculum
- meet the individual needs of your child
- set regular home learning tasks
- provide a comprehensive range of extra-curricular activities to enrich your child's learning
- ensure eSafety is embedded within the school's curriculum and the school provides children with supervised access to the Internet using the Hertfordshire Internet Connection web filtering service
- preview any recommended sites, online services, software and apps before use to provide a safe, secure eSafety environment
- ensure that specific sites that have been set for Internet Research home learning have been previously checked by the teacher

Agreement for Child:

To ensure I achieve my full potential at The Reddings I will:

- work hard and give all new challenges 'a go'
- be proud of my achievements
- make positive behaviour choices and follow our Golden Rules
- be polite, kind and helpful to other children and adults in and around the school
- be able to ask adults for support and advice
- be prepared to help other children in my class and around the school
- be safe when using the Internet and remember to use the eSafety rules
- abide by school's ICT Acceptable Use policy, including not making defamatory comments about staff, pupils and parents. This refers to all forms of communication including the use of social networking sites e.g Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat and YouTube (most of which carry a 13+ age limit for usage)
- complete my home learning on time and enjoy reading with people at home
- come to school every day and arrive on time
- be a good ambassador for The Reddings School and wear the correct uniform with pride

Agreement for Parents/Carers:

To ensure my child achieves their full potential at The Reddings I / we will:

- agree with the school in its Visions, Values, Aims and policies
- ensure my child is punctual and attends school daily
- communicate with the school to resolve any issues
- respond to school correspondence
- communicate with all staff at The Reddings School in a respectful manner
- encourage my child to complete learning tasks, and follow the Golden Rules
- ensure my child wears the correct school uniform with pride
- support the school approach to on-line safety ensuring my/our online activity will not include uploading or adding any text, image, sounds or videos that could upset, offend or cause distress any member of the school community or bring the school name into disrepute.
- support the school's policy and help prevent my/our children from signing up to services such as Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat and YouTube whilst they are underage (13+ years in most cases) I/we will close online accounts if I/we/teachers find that these accounts are active for our underage child/children
- ensure my child is kept safe when using the Internet and be fully aware of their Internet activity
- understand that cyber bullying on any of the social networking sites, including Facebook and Twitter, will not be tolerated. This includes defamatory comments about staff, children and parents. These incidents will be reported to the appropriate authority
- to report any concerns you have directly to school and not share concerns or observations with other parents as this may constitute a breach of trust – this includes the use of social media (Facebook) to make comments about issues with school
