	Skill
Exploring and developing ideas (ONGOING)	Record and explore ideas from first hand observation, experience and imagination.
	Ask and answer questions about the starting points for their work, and develop their ideas.
	Explore the differences and similarities within the work of artists, craftspeople and designers in different times and cultures.
	Ask and answer questions about the starting points for their work and the processes they have used.
Evaluating and developing work (ONGOING)	Review what they and others have done and say what they think and feel about it.
	Identify what they might change in their current work or develop in their future work.
Drawing (ONGOING)	Use a variety of tools, inc. pencils, rubbers, crayons, pastels, felt tips, charcoal, ballpoints, chalk and other dry media.
Textiles/ Collage	Use a variety of techniques, e.g. weaving, finger knitting, fabric crayons, sewing and binca.
	How to thread a needle, cut, glue and trim material.
	Create images from imagination, experience or observation.
	Use a wide variety of media, inc. photocopied material, fabric, plastic, tissue, magazines, crepe paper, etc.
Painting	Use a variety of tools and techniques including the use of different brush sizes and types.
	Mix and match colours to artefacts and objects.
	Work on different scales.
	Mix secondary colours and shades using different types of paint.
	Create different textures e.g. use of sawdust and sand.
